

Death Wish? (Philippians 1:21-23)

Did the Apostle Paul have a death wish? After reading this passage from the letter to the Philippian church, some may believe Paul wished to die. Writing from a Roman prison he penned, "For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain." (Philippians 1:21) He would go on to say in the following verses that he was conflicted in his desire to be with Christ, which would be far better, or remain alive in order to serve the dear saints for which he felt so deeply. But if we take a contextual look at the first chapter of Philippians, we can see the confidence that Paul possessed. "For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance (salvation) through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ." (v. 19) From his dire situation, the inspired apostle could see the big picture.

Just as Paul could visualize God's plan for his life, you and I can experience the understanding of an abundant life in Christ. (John 10:10) Upon obedience to the gospel message, we gain the confidence and knowledge of our forgiveness and salvation. (1 John 5:13) Of course we must be realist and face the fact that all must die and stand before God in the judgment. (Heb. 9:27) But the journey toward the certainty of death does not have to be a miserable one. From the words of Jesus to the epistles, we can learn to experience a life of the joy, peace, and anticipation of being with Christ. No, this is not morbid nor is it a death wish.
